

Berry Bros. & Rudd tops the bill of a major new television series on wine

30th January 2009...The first programme in the BBC's new series, 'Wine: The Firm', is based around the UK's oldest wine merchant Berry Bros. & Rudd and charts a year in a life of the family business.

Starring Berrys' buyers Jasper Morris MW and Simon Staples, the programme explores the relationships between these larger than life characters and the winemakers and chateaux owners of Burgundy and Bordeaux.
